The German volunteers offered referees and kids' training camps during their stay in Mzansi.

All the participants received T-shirts while winning teams received full-kits organised by Matthias from European Football Associations like Switzerland and Portugal.

The boys' tournament was won by Imizamo Yethu FC Hout Bay followed closely by Mobz Academy in the second spot.

Other teams were Portugal, Bafana United, Women for Peace, Kolping Association, Hasco United, iThemba Labantu FC, Kwamfundo Sec School, Isikhokelo Primary School, Noluthando School for the Deaf and New World Foundation. The girls tournament was won by Harry Gwala High Schools whilst Hout Bay came second.
